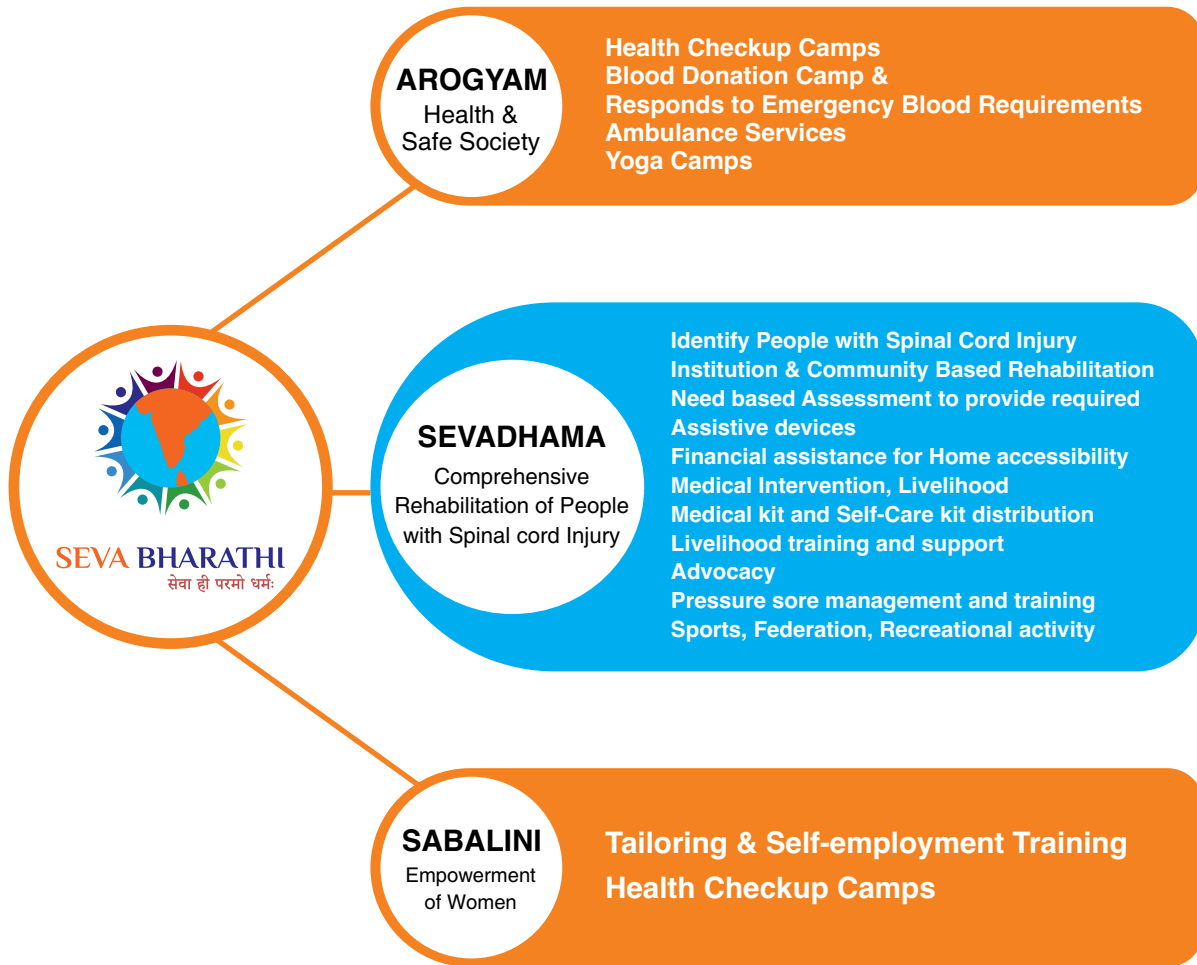

People with spinal cord injury are rehabilitated by providing physiotherapy, occupational therapy and assistive devices. Shifting skills & training on independent activities of daily living are thought to ensure no spinal cords injured are bedridden or dependent on their family. We ensure all people with spinal cord injury are identified, rehabilitated and learn self-management skills, take care of their daily routine and lead happy independent life with confidence.

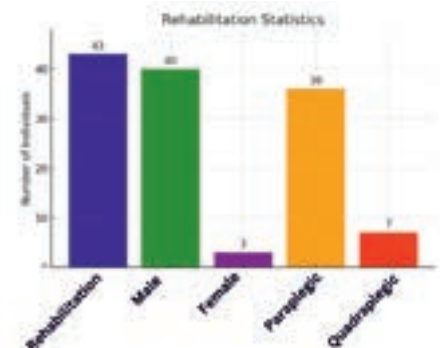

Institution Based Rehabilitation

Institution based rehabilitation provides residential rehabilitation services, where identified people with spinal cord injuries are admitted to the center for around 2–3 months, and extended services are offered. This concept of institution-based rehabilitation brings larger changes and independency in people with spinal cord injury as engaged in on a daily basis. For the well-being of physical, social and psychological growth, people with spinal cord injuries are engaged in various activities like yoga, aerobics, mudra, physiotherapy, occupational therapy and training on various factors like shifting skills, wheelchair skills, livelihood, and activities of daily living.

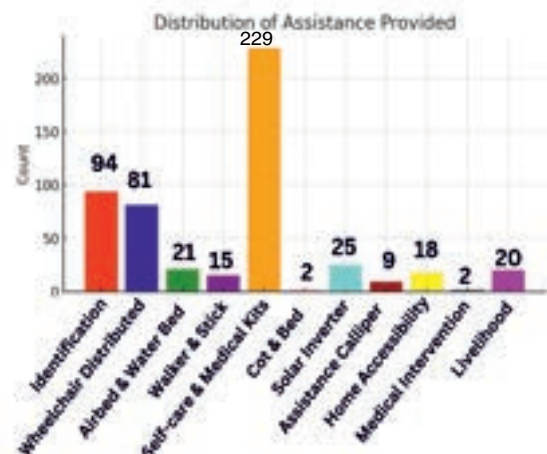

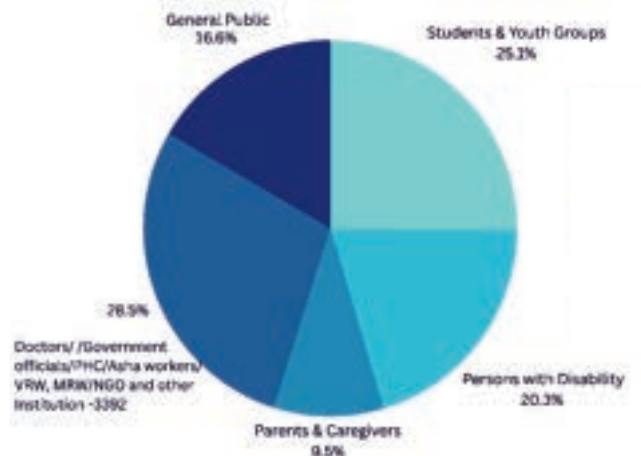

Solar Intervention

Our community intervention found that the most common and serious problem is the management of skin. Around 15% of identified people with spinal cord injury are facing problems of pressure sore. This made us concentrate on skin management. Training them with positioning skills and providing them with an airbed was the only way to get rid of the pressure sore. So, our initiative of providing airbed to those who are suffering from pressure sores was rightly supported by the Selco Foundation. Under this initiative, 25 people with spinal cord injury were provided with a solar setup. Solar power and equipment provided by Selco helped the beneficiary to have a continuous power supply, which helped the airbed to operate efficiently. This resulted in speedy recovery of pressure sore.

The Inspiring Story of

Mr. Anthony A Reformer

In February of 2022, a tragic incident changed the life of a 27 year-old boy. What seemed like a moment of despair would eventually lead him on a journey of transformation. With no confidence to recover, no knowledge of survival, and no hope in his heart, he spent a year bedridden, trying to make sense of a future that seemed lost. But fate had a different plan for him. A ray of hope appeared in the form of Sevadhama, which became the catalyst for his incredible journey from dependence to independence and from trainee to trainer.

This is the story of Mr. Anthony, a reformer from Chikkamagaluru, who turned his life around and now helps others find their way to independence.

After completing his Pre-University Course (PUC), Anthony, a young man with immense responsibility towards his family, set out to pursue his career in the IT capital of India, Bangalore. He worked there for four years, but eventually, the call of his roots led him back to his village, where he chose to rely on agriculture for his livelihood.

However, fate struck again. A fall from an areca tree resulted in a severe spinal cord injury, leaving Antony bedridden. Although surgery helped stabilize his condition and relieve the pain, he remained completely dependent on others, with little hope of leading an independent life. For a year, Antony struggled with his situation, feeling lost and hopeless.

Then, a breakthrough came when he connected with Sevadhama, a rehabilitation center that would change his life forever. At Sevadhama, he received guidance, therapy, and education on life skills and independence. The rehabilitation process taught him how to regain control of his life and empowered him to look beyond his physical limitations.

With newfound hope, Anthony decided to use the knowledge and skills he gained to help others facing similar challenges. He took it upon himself to be a source of inspiration and change for his community. His journey didn't stop there—he went on to receive advanced training from APD, Bengaluru and IIT Madras.

Today, Anthony is a peer trainer at Sevabharathi, where he trains people with spinal cord injuries (PwSCI) on life skills and independence. His transformation from a bedridden, hopeless individual to a confident and capable trainer is a testament to his resilience, determination, and the power of community support.

Anthony's story is not just about overcoming personal challenges - it's about how one person's journey can become a beacon of hope for others. From being a trainee to becoming a trainer, Anthony now helps others lead better, more independent lives, proving that no matter the odds, it is never too late to change, learn, and inspire.



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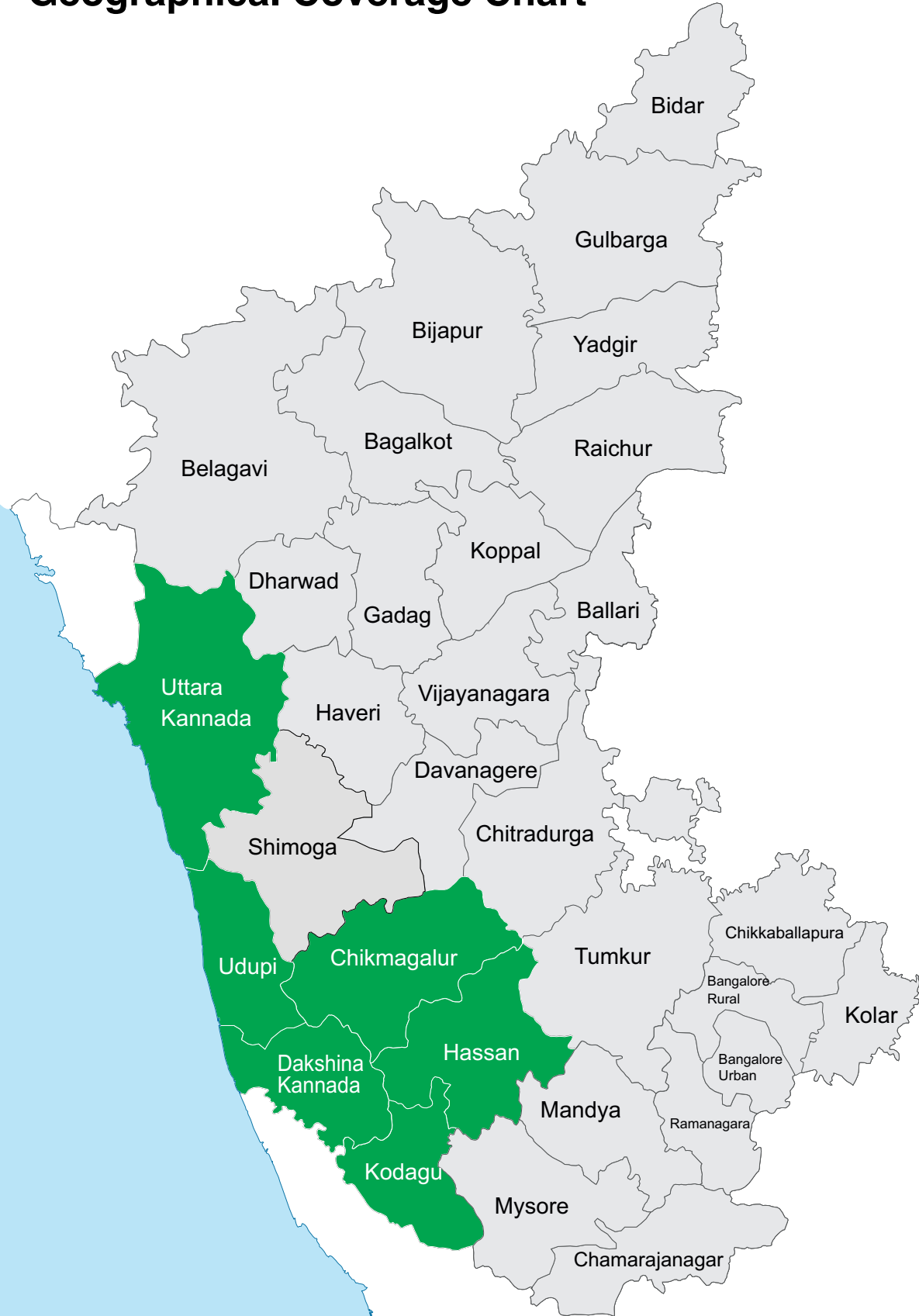

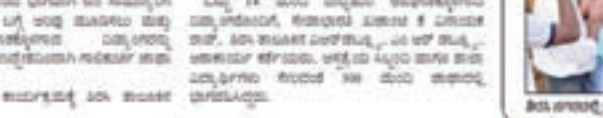
